HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

Relating to assistance of the Legislative Affairs Agency at the second annual Boys' State.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the second annual Boys' State program will be held on the campus and facilities of the Copper Valley School near Glennallen, Alaska, beginning on June 2, 1968; and

WHEREAS at Boys' State the delegates learn the duties of the various offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

WHEREAS the staff of the Legislative Affairs Agency could be of invaluable aid to the operation of the Boys' State program by preparing materials necessary for a better understanding of the legislative process and by having staff members in attendance at Boys' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fifth State Legislature directs the Legislative Council to authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and, if desired by the Boys' State chairmen, to have two staff members attend the second annual Boys' State to aid the delegates in the legislative program.
