HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 30

Relating to memorial plaques honoring the war dead of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS many Alaskans have served with distinction in all of our country's declared and undeclared wars; and

WHEREAS many of these brave and dedicated men have paid the ultimate price as a result of their service to their state and country; and

WHEREAS many other states honor their war dead by erecting plaques in appropriate locations in memory of those citizens of their state who have given their lives for their country;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fifth State Legislature respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Public Works to erect in the legislative halls on the second floor of the State Capitol Building appropriate plaques honoring those Alaskans who have served and died in the defense of their country.
