HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 32

Relating to a study of industrial and other related accidents.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the frequency and severity of industrial and other related accidents in Alaska has been extremely high; and

WHEREAS it is in everyone's interest to emphasize safe working and living conditions; and

WHEREAS there is a need for the collection and analysis of information on industrial and other related accidents;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council, in cooperation with the Department of Labor, is directed to make a study of the causes of and possible preventive measures for industrial and other related accidents and to make a full report of its findings to the Fifth State Legislature, Second Session.
