HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 37

Welcoming The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, President of the Federal Republic of Germany, and his entourage to the State of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, during a long and distinguished career in the service of the German people, has demonstrated his deep and active commitment to the cause of freedom and justice; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of such commitment and his manifold services to the Federal Republic of Germany during its formative years, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke has been elected and now serves as the President and Head of State of the said Federal Republic of Germany; and

WHEREAS, in the discharge of his official duties, and with the commendable objective of furthering international understanding among peoples of diverse cultures and political, social, and economic systems, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke has undertaken an extensive and demanding journey to various nations on the Asian continent; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, while en route from his nation's capital city to Seoul, capital city of the Republic of Korea, on February 28, 1967, will break his journey at Anchorage, largest city of the State of Alaska, and will remain therein for a period of one day; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is the gateway of the United States of America to the vast continent of Asia, and the people of Alaska share in a very special way the concern of The Honorable Heinrich Luebke and his government that there be a mutually

rewarding understanding among the peoples of the West and East;
and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is honored and privileged to have the opportunity to welcome through its Governor and other public officials and citizens The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, Mrs. Luebke, and the other official and nonofficial members of his entourage;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska on behalf of all the people of Alaska extends its welcome to The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, President of the Federal Republic of Germany, to his gracious wife, and to the several dignitaries, officials, representatives, and employees of his government and representatives of news media who accompany him, expresses its fervent hope that his mission will contribute to better understanding among the peoples of the world and to the realization of peace with justice among the nations, and wishes him and those who accompany him "Gute Reise"; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution, suitably enrolled, be presented to The Honorable Heinrich Luebke on behalf of the Legislature by Representative William J. Moran, Honorary Consul of the Federal Republic of Germany for Alaska.
