HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 50

Relating to a study to be made by the Division of Employment Security.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there are a great many untrained and unemployed people in the Bethel area; and

WHEREAS the Kodiak area, Aleutian Chain area, and other areas of the state have many job opportunities especially during certain times of the year; and

WHEREAS there is a need for more knowledge on how these two factors might be reconciled;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Labor, Employment Security Division, to conduct a study of the unemployment situation in the Bethel area with a view toward establishing a training program and making Bethel area labor available to the Kodiak and Aleutian Chain areas and to other areas in the state that have jobs available, and to make a report of its findings to the Fifth Legislature, Second Session.
