HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 53

Relating to an Alaska Fisherman's Day.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the fishing industry is the largest single industry in Alaska; and

WHEREAS the people of the state should be made more aware of the fishing industry and its products from the sea; and

WHEREAS fishermen need a time and place where they can go to see the modern equipment developed for the fishing industry; and

WHEREAS fishermen should be encouraged to get together once a year and demonstrate to people of the state their wares and skills;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to proclaim to the state an Alaska Fisherman's Day, and that this day be the last Saturday of September; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to encourage the fishermen to gather together and establish a fisherman's trade fair at which fish products are displayed and sold, competition in fishing skills are conducted, and the newest in fish gear and methods is displayed by vendors of marine products.
