## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 54

Honoring the memory of the late Dan Mahoney.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has suffered a great loss by the passing of Dan Mahoney; and

WHEREAS Dan Mahoney was a native Alaskan born in Ketchikan who spent his life in the public service of both his state and nation; and

WHEREAS Dan Mahoney was an outstanding citizen of the Territory and State of Alaska, and served the people of Alaska for 26 years in many important capacities, having served in the Veterans Administration and represented Veterans in the Division of Employment Security, and was State Director of the Selective Service System since 1961; and

WHEREAS he rendered distinguished service to the people of both the state and nation by being the first Alaska enlistee in 1941, and rising in his military career to the rank of a full Colonel; and

WHEREAS his distinguished service to Alaska in many capacities rendered with dedication earned him the esteem of countless Alaskans;

BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Fifth State Legislature extend their sincerest expression of regard and esteem for the late Dan Mahoney and the contributions he made to Alaska,
