JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to passage of a federal flood insurance program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS United States Senate Bill No. 1985 would create a federal flood insurance program in which a property owner in a flood-prone area would pay a reasonable premium designed to encourage him to purchase flood insurance and the federal government would subsidize the difference between this premium and the full actuarial cost of writing the insurance for the policy; and

WHEREAS the program proposed by this Senate Bill would greatly benefit the entire country, including many areas of Alaska, in the event of future floods; and

WHEREAS Senate Bill No. 1985 has passed the United States Senate without a dissenting vote and is now being considered by the House of Representatives;

BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. House of Representatives is respectfully urged to approve Senate Bill No. 1985 providing for an effective flood insurance program.
