JOINT RESOLUTION

Urging the development of harbor facilities adjacent to the City of Unalaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS adjacent to the City of Unalaska there is a landlocked harbor known as Margaret Bay on Amuknak Island; and

WHEREAS to make Margaret Bay a valuable harbor would require only the dredging of the entrance and the installation of the necessary moorage facilities; and

WHEREAS there is a great number of boats in need of these facilities; and

WHEREAS if this project at Margaret Bay can be surveyed and action taken immediately, it could be done at the same time as the King Cove project and thereby result in a great savings in time and money;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of the Army is respectfully requested to take immediate action to determine the requirements for and build a harbor at Margaret Bay.
