## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to airline excursion rates.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska Airlines, Wien Alaska Airlines, and Western Airlines offer excursion rates to various points in Alaska which are cheaper than regular flight fares; and

WHEREAS these lower fares facilitate more extensive utilization of air transportation for tourists and businessmen; and

WHEREAS the present policy of these three airlines is that excursion fare tickets cannot be exchanged between airlines without having to pay a full fare upon transfer; and

WHEREAS it is in the public interest, and the public good demands that a passenger who has purchased an excursion ticket on one of the airlines should be able to freely transfer to another airline, offering an excursion fare with no increase in the price of the ticket;

BE IT RESOLVED that Alaska Airlines, Wien Alaska Airlines, and Western Airlines are requested to change their transfer policy with regard to excursion fares to allow transfers between airlines with no increase in cost.
