## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 14

Relating to the development of a frozen pea industry in the state.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS there is the possibility in Alaska of the development of an untapped agricultural resource; and

WHEREAS the state needs to broaden its economic base; and

WHEREAS for a number of years peas have been grown in Alaska; and

WHEREAS the growing of peas and the commercial freezing of them for export presents a potential for added economic growth of the state; and

WHEREAS, in order to increase the production and utilization of peas on a commercial scale for the basis and development of a frozen food industry, there is a need for a comprehensive study into the feasibility of such an industry;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Economic Development to undertake a comprehensive feasibility study of the production and utilization of peas on a commercial scale as a basis for the development of a frozen food industry in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that a report of the findings be made to the Sixth Legislature, First Session.
