HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 3

Commending the winner of the 1968 Fur Rendezvous World Championship Sled Dog Races.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the annual Fur Rendezvous in Anchorage this year witnessed one of the most exciting and grueling world championship sled dog races ever run; and

WHEREAS the victor in the three heat event was George Attla, a native Alaskan from Huslia, who captured the crown previously in 1958 and again in 1962; and

WHEREAS George Attla's brilliant performance in regaining the sled dog racing championship for himself and for Alaska gives rise to a feeling of great pride on the part of the people of the state;
