HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 5

Relating to the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings winning the state basketball crown.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the West Anchorage Eagles, western Alaska basketball champions have met the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings, the southeastern Alaska champions, to compete for the state basketball title; and

WHEREAS the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings defeated the West Anchorage Eagles this week in the best of a three-game competition, thus winning the 1968 state basketball crown; and

WHEREAS the Kayhi Kings have been southeastern Alaska champions for five consecutive years and this is the fourth consecutive year the state basketball championship has been won by the Ketchikan team, a record never before equaled in the annals of Alaska basketball history; and

WHEREAS the West Anchorage Eagles fought hard for the title and demonstrated the best in good sportsmanship throughout the competition;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives extends to the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings and the West Anchorage Eagles its commendation on the winning of their regional titles; salutes both teams for the climactic state competition this week; and expresses its heartiest congratulations to the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings team and to head coach Claude Hunsakor and assistant coach Robert Vincent for their victory in winning the state basketball crown for the fourth consecutive year.
