HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 7

Relating to the late Bernard J. Carr, Sr.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS death has removed from the state a distinguished citizen, The Honorable Bernard J. Carr, Sr.; and
