SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

Expressing appreciation to the Salvation Army for disaster relief services rendered the state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, in the face of great adversity, the Salvation Army rendered vital services to the people of the state following the flood of August 14, 1967; and

WHEREAS these valiant and tireless men and women were among the first to rush into the stricken areas to minister to those in need and to care for the disaster stricken; and

WHEREAS the devotion and skill, effort, and resources of the Salvation Army organization and staff in furnishing badly needed food supplies and clothing to the flood victims are in the highest traditions of their profession and calling and command the appreciation of all the people of the State of Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska extends, on behalf of the people of Alaska, the gratitude and commendation of the state to the Salvation Army for its past assistance and continuing service to the people of the state.
