JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to civilian use of the fuel pipeline from Haines to Fairbanks.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the cost of transporting fuel to the Fairbanks area is extremely high and results in a high cost of living in that area; and

WHEREAS the military pipeline between Haines and Fairbank could be made available for civilian purposes since the military requirements do not demand full time use; and

WHEREAS civilian use of this pipeline would result in a lower cost for fuel in the Fairbanks area, would make possible an increase in general aviation and additional air service, and would aid significantly in lowering the cost of living in this area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of Defense and the Commander-in-Chief of the Alaska Command are requested to allow the pipeline between Haines and Fairbanks to be used for the transportation of fuel for civilian purposes.
