## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the establishment of a post office at Kongiganak, Alaska.

---

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA :

WHEREAS the village of Kongiganak, Alaska, located on the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta on the western shore of Kuskokwim Bay, does not have a post office; and

WHEREAS communication facilities are vital for the development of isolated areas of Alaska and for the normal comforts of the residents of those areas; and

WHEREAS the people of Kongiganak desire a post office; and

WHEREAS a post office would serve the immediate area of Kongiganak as well as the western Kuskokwim Bay area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully requested to establish a post office at Kongiganak, Alaska.

Bartlett and The Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and The Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
