SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1

Requesting expanded postal service for Gakona and Tok.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the postal facilities now serving the communities of Gakona and Tok now receive and have mail picked up only once each week; and

WHEREAS the service now received emanates from the U.S. Post Office at Glennallen; and

WHEREAS the mail trucks providing service out of Glennallen pass through the communities of Gakona and Tok more than once each week but stop only once for mail delivery and pickup; and

WHEREAS the residents of these communities desire and need a more frequent schedule of mail service;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Lawrence O'Brien, Postmaster General of the United States, is respectfully requested to explore the feasibility of providing the communities of Gakona and Tok, Alaska, with twice weekly mail delivery and pickup service through the facilities of the U.S. Post Office at Glennallen, Alaska.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Lawrence O'Brien, Postmaster General of the United States; and the Honorable E.L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
