SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 10

Relating to the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings winning the state basketball crown.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the West Anchorage Eagles, western Alaska basketball champions have met the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings, the southeast Alaska champions, to compete for the state basketball title; and

WHEREAS the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings defeated the West Anchorage Eagles this past weekend in a three-game competition, thus winning the 1967 state basketball crown; and

WHEREAS this is the third consecutive year that the state basketball championship has been won by the Ketchikan team;
