## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

Requesting the Governor to direct a feasibility study of state drydocking facilities construction.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the construction of drydocking facilities for use by the state may be of important advantage in accomplishing state purposes; and

WHEREAS the possibility of the state's constructing drydocking facilities requires and merits investigation as to its feasibility and foreseeable need and benefits to the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Works, its Division of Marine Transportation and Division of Waters and Harbors, the Department of Highways, the Department of Economic Development, and other authorities of the state as the Governor may determine appropriate to conduct a joint economic and engineering survey and feasibility study determining the need, costs, and site alternatives relating to possible construction of state drydocking facilities and to report findings to the Legislature at the earliest possible date.
