AN ACT

Relating to departmental boards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.05.060 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.05.060. APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS, AND TERMS OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF DEPARTMENTAL BOARDS, COUNCILS, OR COMMISSIONS. Each member of the Local Boundary Commission, Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, Employment Security Advisory Council, Alaska State Housing Authority, Board of Fish and Game, and the Commission for Northern Operations of Rail Transportation and Highways, shall be a citizen of the United States. The governor shall appoint each member on the basis of interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge and ability in the field of action of the department for which appointed, and with a view to providing diversity of interest and points of view in the membership. Appointments are subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session. Initial appointments of members are as follows: (1) in the case of three-member boards, for one, two and three years; (2) in the case of five-member boards, for one, two, three, four and five years; (3) in the case of six-member boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, and two for three years; (4) in the case of eight-member boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for three years, and two for four years; (5) and in the case of 10-member boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for three years, two for four years, and two for five years. Initial terms date from February 1 before appointment. A vacancy occurring during a term of office is filled in the same manner as the original appointment is made and for the balance of the unexpired term. Each member holds office at the pleasure of the governor notwithstanding the member's term.

* Sec. 2. AS 23.30.005(a) is amended to read:

(a) The Alaska Workmen's Compensation Board shall consist of five members, including a southern panel of three members sitting for the first judicial district and a northern panel of three members sitting for the second, third and fourth judicial districts. Each panel shall include the commissioner of labor or his designated representative, a representative of industry and a representative of labor. The latter two members of each panel shall be appointed by the governor. All panel members are subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session.

* Sec. 3. AS 33.15.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 33.15.010. STATE BOARD OF PAROLE. There is in the department a board of parole consisting of five members to be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session. One of the members, who shall be chairman of the board, shall be a person with training or experience in the field of probation and parole, and he may be an official or employee of the department but may not be an official or employee of the youth and adult authority. The term of each of the other four members of the board is four years and until his successor is appointed and qualifies. Successors are appointed in the same manner as provided for the board members first appointed. A vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term.

* Sec. 4. AS 08.64.020 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.64.020. STATE MEDICAL BOARD TERM OF OFFICE. Members shall be appointed for a term of four years, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session, and shall hold office until their successors are appointed and qualified.
