AN ACT

Relating to notice of proposed regulations by administrative agencies; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.62.200 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.62.200. CONTENTS OF NOTICE. (a) The notice of proposed adoption, amendment, or repeal of a regulation shall include

(1) a statement of the time, place, and nature of proceedings for adoption, amendment, or repeal of the regulation;

(2) reference to the authority under which the regulation is proposed and a reference to the particular code section or other provisions of law which are being implemented, interpreted, or made specific;

(3) an informative summary of the proposed subject of agency action;

(4) other matters prescribed by a statute applicable to the specific agency or to the specific regulation or class of regulations.

(b) A regulation which is adopted, amended or repealed may vary in content from the summary specified in (a)(3) of this section if the subject matter of the regulation remains the same and the original notice was written so as to assure that members of the public are reasonably notified of the proposed subject of agency action in order for them to determine whether their interests could be affected by agency action on that subject.

* Sec. 2. The proposed regulations of the Department of Public

Safety (13 AAC 04.280, 13 AAC 04.285, 13 AAC 04.290, 13 AAC 04.-295, and 13 AAC 04.300) shall not be effective until April 1, 1971.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
