## AN ACT

Relating to land selections by local governments.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 07.10.150 is amended to read:

Sec. 07.10.150. STATE LANDS. An organized borough may select 10 per cent of the vacant, unappropriated, unreserved state lands located in its boundaries. Nothing in this section affects any valid existing claim, location, or entry under the laws of the state or the United States, whether for homestead, mineral, right-of-way, or other purpose, or affects the rights of any owner, claimant, locator, or entryman to the full use and enjoyment of the land so occupied.

\* Sec. 2. AS 07.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 07.05.040. STATE LANDS. A city of the first or second class may select 10 per cent of the vacant, unappropriated, unreserved state lands located in its boundaries. Nothing in this section affects any valid existing claim, location or entry under the laws of the state or the United States whether for homestead, mineral, right-of-way, or other purpose, or affects the rights of any owner, claimant, locator, or entryman to the full use and enjoyment of the land so occupied.
