AN ACT

Permitting a single body to serve as both the school board and assembly of an organized borough upon voter approval.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.12.110. SINGLE BODY AS ASSEMBLY AND SCHOOL BOARD. Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter or other law, a single body may serve as both the borough assembly and borough school board in the manner provided for third class boroughs under AS 07.17.030, if a borough ordinance for that purpose is approved by the assembly and ratified by a referendum of a majority of the qualified borough voters voting on the question at a regular or special election, and if the public school population within the borough is 500 pupils or less.
