AN ACT

Relating to the marketing of salmon.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.10.290. PRICE DISPUTES BETWEEN FISHERMEN AND FISH PROCESSORS. In an area where a price dispute exists between at least one-third of the registered commercial fishermen for that area as certified by the Department of Fish and Game and fish processors on the price to be paid for salmon, and no agreement has been reached up to 30 days before the opening of the salmon fishing season in that area, a representative from the Department of Labor shall intervene as mediator of the dispute upon request of either party.
