## AN ACT

Relating to educational assistance for members of the Alaska National Guard.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 26.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 26.05.295. EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE. (a) Each active member of the Alaska National Guard who has completed the initial voluntary enlistment period of service which fulfills the mandatory requirement for military service under the Selective Service Act of 1967 (50 USC 454 - 456), is eligible for educational assistance benefits in Alaska educational facilities.

(b) Educational programs and monetary benefits available to persons under (a) of this section are based on and equivalent to those of the federal veterans administration education program (38 USC 1651-1687).

(c) For the purposes of computing eligible benefits under the Alaska educational assistance program, each retirement point earned as a member of the Alaska National Guard is equivalent to one day's active military service. Computation of credit for retirement points is based on the retirement credits record in accordance with existing federal National Guard and Reserve regulations.
