AN ACT

Authorizing the construction of a life-sized statue of Senator E. L. "Bob" Bartlett; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. For the purpose of constructing a life-sized statue of the late Senator E. L. "Bob" Bartlett for permanent placement in the Capitol Rotunda in Washington, D. C., the Alaska State Council on the Arts shall

(1) work with federal officials to determine what requirements and standards must be met for such a statue; and

(2) select a sculptor to make the statue, and out of its own funds negotiate a contract with him.

* Sec. 2. Final approval of the person who shall receive the commission rests with Mrs. Vide Bartlett. The commissioned sculptor shall have all details, including the model to be used, approved by Mrs. Bartlett, and the final product shall also be approved by Mrs. Bartlett before placement of the statue in the Capitol Rotunda.

* Sec. 3. The contract with the sculptor shall include the production of a bust of the late senator taken from the life-sized statue. This bust shall be for presentation to the University of Alaska.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
