AN ACT

Relating to process of the district court.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 22.15.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 22.15.140. PROCESS. Process of the district court shall be in the name of the State of Alaska, be signed by the district judge, magistrate, clerk or deputy clerk of the district court in the judicial district where the process is issued, be dated when issued, sealed with the seal of the court, and made returnable according to rule prescribed by the supreme court and shall run throughout the state.
