## AN ACT

Providing for filing of employer's report of alleged injury or death.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.30.070(a) is amended to read:

(a) Within 10 days from the date the employer has knowledge of an injury or death or from the date the employer has knowledge of a disease or infection, alleged by the employee or on his behalf to have arisen out of and in the course of the employment, the employer shall send to the board a report setting out

- (1) the name, address, and business of the employer;
- (2) the name, address, and occupation of the employee;
- (3) the cause and nature of the alleged injury or death;
- (4) the year, month, day, and hour when and the particular locality where the alleged injury or death occurred; and
- (5) the other information which the board may require.
