AN ACT

Relating to fiscal responsibilities of the Department of Revenue; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 43.05.170 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 43.05.170. PAYMENT OF WARRANTS. Upon presentation for payment the Department of Revenue shall pay all warrants drawn by the Department of Administration against the state treasury, which have been properly endorsed and have not been cancelled by law. Warrants made payable to two or more persons in an amount less than \$50 may be paid if endorsed by only one of the designated payees.

* Sec. 2. AS 43.05.180 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 43.05.180. ACCOUNTING FOR STATE FUNDS. The Department of Revenue shall keep an account of money received, money disbursed and money and investments in its custody.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
