AN ACT

Relating to the persons eligible to receive workmen's compensation benefits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30.265(7) is amended to read:

(7) "child," "grandchild," "brother," and "sister," include only persons who are under 19 years of age, persons who, though 19 years of age or over, are wholly dependent upon the deceased employee and incapable of self-support by reason of mental or physical disability, and persons of any age while they are attending the first four years vocational school, trade school, or college, and persons of any age while they are attending high school;
