AN ACT

Relating to door-to-door solicitation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 45.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 45.05.125. SALE BY DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATION.

(a) A contract for the purchase of retail goods or services in the amount of \$10 or more from a salesman soliciting door-to-door shall require, as a condition of taking effect, that the purchaser may revoke his offer to buy within 72 hours of entering into the contract. Revocation is effective either upon the tender of the rejected goods to the seller or his agent, or, if the goods have not been delivered, upon the posting of a letter of rejection to the seller or his agent. Sales in which the buyer requested the seller or his agent to come to his home are exempted from this subsection.

(b) The cost of returning rejected goods shall be borne by the seller.
