AN ACT

Relating to fire safety in certain remote housing facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.70 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 2. FIRE PROTECTION.

Sec. 18.70.082. REMOTE HOUSING FACILITIES. Any construction camp, logging camp, cannery, oil, or mining camp that has buildings not in a fire department service area in which persons are housed in dormitories or similar facilities shall be equipped with an automatic fire detection system in that portion of the building used for living or sleeping purposes. In this chapter an automatic fire detection system means a type of automatic fire detection system approved by the state fire marshal.
