AN ACT

Relating to work and rehabilitation furloughs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 33.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 33.30.260. REHABILITATION FURLOUGHS. The commissioner may authorize a prisoner to participate in educational, training, medical, psychiatric, or other rehabilitation programs approved by the commissioner. When the prisoner is not participating in a rehabilitation program, he shall be confined in the jail unless the commissioner directs otherwise. If the prisoner violates the conditions established for his conduct or custody, the commissioner may order the balance of the prisoner's sentence to be spent in actual confinement. The wilful failure of a prisoner to return to the place of confinement not later than the expiration of any period during which he is authorized to be away from the place of confinement under this section, is an escape from the place of confinement and is punishable under the laws relating to escape.

* Sec. 2. AS 33.30.250(g)(2), (4), (5) and (6) are repealed.
