AN ACT

Amending the Pharmacy Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.80.030 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(5) promulgate regulations to carry out the purposes of this chapter.

* Sec. 2. AS 08.80.110 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.80.110. QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION. An applicant for registration as a pharmacist shall

(1) be a citizen of the United States and fluent in the reading, writing and speaking of the English language;

(2) furnish the board with at least two affidavits from reputable citizens attesting to his good moral character and freedom from addiction to the use of drugs or alcoholic liquors;

(3) be a graduate of a college of pharmacy recognized by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy;

(4) pass an examination by a board of pharmacy which board has been approved by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy;

(5) have completed, after graduation, an internship of 540 hours under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist in a licensed pharmacy.

Sec. 08.80.140. LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY. The board may register without examination an applicant who has been certified as a registered pharmacist by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy, provided the applicant has complied with sec. 110(5) of this chapter.
