## AN ACT

Relating to the confidentiality of employment security records; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.20.110(a) is amended to read:

(a) The department shall hold information obtained from an employing unit or individual in the course of administering this chapter and determinations as to the benefit rights of an individual confidential and may not disclose them or open them to public inspection in a manner which reveals the identity of the individual or employing unit. A claimant or his legal representative is entitled to information from the records of the department to the extent necessary for the proper presentation of his claim in a proceeding under this chapter. Subject to restrictions which the department prescribes by regulation the information may be made available to an agency of this state or another state or federal agency charged with the administration of an unemployment compensation law or the maintenance of a system of public employment offices, or, for the purposes of the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, to the Internal Revenue Service of the United States, or, for tax purposes, to the Department of Revenue. Information obtained in connection with the administration of the employment service may be made available to persons or agencies for purposes appropriate to the operation of a public employment service.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
