## AN ACT

Relating to the Japanese World Fair of 1970; granting powers and duties necessary to an Alaska exhibit; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. This Act authorizes and directs the construction and operation of an Alaska exhibit in the Japanese World Fair of 1970. All powers and authority necessary to the accomplishment of this project are granted by this Act to any department of the state which can contribute assistance or skills.

\* Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. The Department of Economic Development shall

(1) plan and administer all official state activities leading up to and relating to the 1970 Japanese World Fair;

(2) solicit, encourage, and foster participation by Alaska business firms, individuals, and organizations in the Alaska exhibit;

(3) have the power to enter into agreements for use or rental of space within the exhibit building on such terms and conditions as the commissioner of economic development may consider reasonable and consistent with sharing the financial burden to the state of the exhibit;

(4) use its facilities and best efforts to obtain the cooperation and support of individuals, organizations, political subdivisions, and business firms in the Alaska exhibit so that the public is fully informed as to the nature of the exhibit;

(5) have the power to hire personnel necessary for staffing the exhibit and for carrying out its duties established by this Act, who shall be in the partially exempt service under

\* Sec. 3. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS. The Department of Public Works shall

(1) investigate and be responsible for the design, construction, maintenance, and destruction of the exhibit building and site improvements;

(2) be responsible for the selection of an Alaska architect;

(3) do all things necessary to the accomplishment of the purpose of this Act.

\* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
