AN ACT

Relating to the notice required for hearings conducted by the Department of Natural Resources.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 31.05.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 31.05.050. NOTICE. (a) A notice required by this chapter shall be given in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).

(b) Procedures to be followed under (a) of this section do not apply if the nature of the notice is not of a statewide or general application but is concerned only with operations on a single well or within a single field and such modification of procedure is within the authority delegated to the department under sec. 30 of this chapter. A notice required by this chapter shall be given by one publication in a newspaper published in the borough in which the hearing is to be held, or if none is published in the borough, in a newspaper published in this state and circulating within the borough, and posted in at least one public place within the borough, at least 10 days before the date of the hearing. The notice shall be issued in the name of the state, shall be signed by the department, and shall specify the style and number of the proceeding, the time and place of the hearing, and shall briefly state the purpose of the proceeding. The department may also give, or require the giving of, additional notice in a proceeding, or class of proceeding, which it considers necessary or desirable.
