AN ACT

Appropriating \$7,500 to M. A. and Marian Silcott for loss of household goods being lawfully shipped on the Fish and Game motor vessel "HARLIQUIN"; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$7,500 is hereby appropriated from the general fund to reimburse M. A. and Marian Silcott for loss of their household goods which were being shipped on the Fish and Game motor vessel "HARLIQUIN", at the state's convenience, on April 2, 1968 when this vessel burned.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
