AN ACT

Relating to the wildlife stocking of public lands; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.25.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.25.010. PROGRAM ADOPTED. There is adopted a program of stocking lands in the state with valuable game and fur-bearing animals which do not at present occur on these lands. The department is responsible for establishing priorities on the species of animals to be stocked and the area of the stocking. Priorities shall be based on the habitat requirements of the species, the population of native game animals present, and other factors that will effect the successful establishment of the species.

* Sec. 2. AS 16.25.020 - 16.25.060 are repealed.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
