## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Relating to the appointment of a representative for Alaska to the Presidential Prayer Breakfast.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the legislature recognizes that the strength and well-being of a community, a state, or a nation is relative to and dependent upon the spiritual values of its citizens; and

WHEREAS the founding and history of our nation was based on and interwoven with man's belief that God has a hand in the affairs of men; and

WHEREAS the legislature recognizes that in this time of man's unprecedented advancement in science and material things, spiritual values should have increasing emphasis; and

WHEREAS it is good that in the tradition of our forefathers our President should meet with leaders of our nation and the world in attitude of prayer seeking divine guidance;

BE IT RESOLVED that Governor Keith H. Miller is respectfully requested to appoint Jack R. Simpson to represent the Governor, the legislators, and the citizens of Alaska at the Prayer Breakfast with President Richard M. Nixon in Washington, D. C., on February 5, 1970.
