HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 38

Relating to the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears winning the state basketball championship.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears, the Southeast Alaska champions, have played the Lathrop High School Malemutes for the state basketball championship; and

WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears defeated the Lathrop High School Malemutes this week in a three-game competition, thus winning the 1969 state basketball crown; and

WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears, by defeating the Malemutes in three straight games, climaxed one of their most impressive seasons in their history;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature extends to the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears and the Lathrop High School Malemutes its commendation on the winning of their regional titles and salutes both teams for the climactic state competition of this past week; and
