HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

Congratulating the League of Women Voters.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS March 19, 1969 marks the beginning of the 50th Anniversary Celebration Year of the League of Women Voters of the United States; and

WHEREAS the League of Women Voters, which was founded in 1920 primarily to help 20 million women voters to carry out their new responsibilities, has in fact assisted men and women voters alike; and

WHEREAS the League of Women Voters has provided nonpartisan information on candidates and ballot issues before elections, encouraged registration and informed voting and helped generations of women understand the structure and function of government; and

WHEREAS the League of Women Voters of Alaska was established in October, 1967 to this same end; and

WHEREAS the League of Women Voters, while nonpartisan in relation to candidates and political parties, has studied and acted upon many issues of government in the public interest; and

WHEREAS the League of Women Voters of Alaska has strengthened state government in Alaska through such activities as printing and distributing a descriptive booklet of the state government, "Know Your State Alaska", and printing and distributing 60,000 copies of a pro - con voter information flyer;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature by this Resolution congratulates the League of Women Voters for its promotion of informed and active participation of all citizens in government.
