## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 42

Relating to the 1969 Junior National Ski Races.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS winter sporting events are assuming increasing importance in the lives of all Alaskans; and

WHEREAS the terrain and climate in Alaska offers some of the best opportunities for winter sports of any of the states in the United States; and

WHEREAS Alpine and Nordic skiing are nationally popular forms of recreation and competition; and

WHEREAS Alaska skiers have been drawing favorable attention to Alaska by their high competitive standings in Alpine and Nordic ski competition; and

WHEREAS nationally sanctioned ski events are of great public relations value to the State of Alaska and its economic growth and development;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature expresses its most sincere thanks to the Alaska Division of the United States Ski Association for having Alyeska designated as the site for the 1969 Junior National Ski Races, March 17 - 23, 1969; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature wishes the Alaska Division of the United States Ski Association every success in conducting this highly publicized national event.
