HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 49

Commending the winner of the 1969 Open North American Sled Dog Championship.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the annual North American Sled Dog Championship was recently held in Fairbanks and was one of the toughest and most grueling races ever; and
