HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 67

Relating to Warrant Officer Frederick M. Simeonoff, killed in action.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaskans have served with distinction in this nation's declared and undeclared wars, many have made the ultimate sacrifice; and

WHEREAS yet another son -- Frederick M. Simeonoff, born in Kodiak 22 years ago and graduated from the Sheldon Jackson High School in Sitka -- heeded his country's call; and

WHEREAS this young Alaskan volunteered for military training schools culminating in graduation with honors from the helicopter pilot program at Fort Rucker, Alabama; and

WHEREAS seven short weeks following his arrival in Vietnam, Warrant Officer Frederick M. Simeonoff was killed in action when an army helicopter he was co-piloting crashed in a river; and

WHEREAS he was returned from the Vietnam War for burial, April 29, 1970, on Kodiak;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska State Legislature, in recognition of the sacrifice of Warrant Officer Frederick M. Simeonoff, posthumously commends him for his service and extends to his family its deepest sympathy.
