## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to an Alaska Airlines flight between Anchorage and Honolulu.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS a regular flight between Alaska and Hawaii would greatly increase tourism in both of these newest additions to the Union; and

WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Hawaii has recently passed a resolution approving and encouraging such a flight; and

WHEREAS Alaska's congressional delegation has recently recommended to President Nixon that the flight to Honolulu be awarded to Alaska Airlines;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully requests the Civil Aeronautics Board to approve an Alaska Airlines flight between Anchorage and Honolulu.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States; the Honorable Charles S. Murphy, Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics Board; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
