## JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting the rehabilitation of the main seaside road between the Air Force base at Unalakleet and the village.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS at Unalakleet the main seaside road leading to the Air Force base is on an extremely low level, with high tides causing the strip to erode rapidly; and

WHEREAS this constant erosion has created an extremely hazardous condition making the only access to safety impossible to cross; and

WHEREAS, during the flood of 1966, boats had to be utilized three miles from the village, making the rescue operation highly dangerous in view of the drifting debris, broken ice, and terrific pressure of the current; and

WHEREAS there is no reason to suppose that such a flood will not occur in the future;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully requests the Corps of Engineers, United States Army, to rehabilitate and rebuild the access road at Unalakleet to its former seaside road level.

Hardin, Jr., U. S. Army Engineer District, Alaska; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and to the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
