JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the Army Corps of Engineers' recommendation to dredge Sergius and Whitestone Narrows.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA :

WHEREAS Public Law 90-483 authorizes the dredging of Sergius and Whitestone narrows in Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS, as shown by the Corps reports on these projects, this is an extremely important operation in order to render feasible the continued operation of the Alaska Lumber and Pulp Company in Southeastern Alaska; and

WHEREAS the continuing operation of the pulp industry is not only vital to the economy of the State of Alaska but also extremely important to related industries throughout the nation;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the President to include funds to carry out the Army Corps of Engineers' recommendation to dredge these two vital arteries of marine transportation in the budget submitted to Congress and urges Congress to give favorable consideration to this project.
