JOINT RESOLUTION

Recommending Joseph E. Crusey for ambassadorship to Iceland.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Joseph E. Crusey's name has been submitted to the President for appointment as the United States Ambassador to Iceland; and

WHEREAS Mr. Crusey is a patriotic citizen of the highest moral and ethical character and a student of Alaska's historical heritage with an avid interest in the economic and social growth of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS Alaska and Iceland have much in common in their respective environments thus eminently qualifying Mr. Crusey for this ambassadorship since mutual understanding of the problems of the country of Iceland and the State of Alaska would be incalculably beneficial to both the United States and Iceland;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature endorses Mr. Crusey and urges the President of the United States to give favorable consideration for his appointment as ambassador to Iceland.
